PROJECT FOCUS

To refresh its strategy for evaluating the effectiveness of its programming on breaking the intergenerational cycles of incarceration.

KEY ACTIVITIES & DELIVERABLES

- Conducted research to identify pre-existing alternative to incarceration (ATI) programs (including mother-specific diversion programs) and the outcomes being tracked by these programs
- Compiled research findings into an ATI program directory
- Developed a data collection plan outlining current outcomes being tracked by ReMerge, as well as recommendations for future outcomes to consider tracking



ReMerge of Oklahoma County is a pre-trial diversion program that serves high-risk, high-needs mothers facing non-violent felony offenses in Oklahoma County. ReMerge is dedicated to restoring women to their families and their community. Specifically, it seeks to impact Oklahoma's high rate of female incarceration and to serve as a model of the power of rehabilitation.
